Regarding Masks: Because of all of the political and scientific debate about the use of masks, the very topic generates strong reactions among people. Wishing to avoid such debates, I do ask you please to wear masks while assisting at Mass, and for two reasons:

a. Our archbishop has asked us to do so, and made that a requirement for re-opening our parishes. Please do not jeopardize our situation. (The matter has already been brought to my attention.)

b. There are people here in the parish, especially people of vulnerable populations, who are quite afraid of getting sick. Regardless of whether you think their fears are well-founded, I am sure you want to do everything you can to make it easier for people to return to Mass. If by wearing a mask gets more people to come, our whole parish benefits. *Children under seven years old and those with medical conditions that make wearing a mask difficult are exempt from this requirement.

Adjustment to Daily Mass Schedule: We will be having only one Mass per day on weekdays until the arrival of our new pastor, Fr. Dow. Please check the schedule accordingly.
