Dispensation from your obligation to attend the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on Sunday remains in effect through August 1st.

Upgrades to the Gym: As we await the air conditioning units to arrive, we have mostly completed the reconstruction of the gym platform for use as our temporary sanctuary. We are very grateful to Orlando Aguirre, Landon Chancey and the others who worked daily on this project for the last week. They have done a great job. Thank you also to the dozens of people who volunteered when needed for other connected jobs. Regarding the finances of all of the gym upgrades (including the AC and platform), we estimate that the total costs will be approximately \$80,000.

I am very happy to report to you that we have received—unsolicited—three pledges of donations totalling approximately \$50,000 towards this project, \$45,000 of which was pledged by one family, for which we are very grateful. Thank you very much to all who offered talent, time and treasure to this project!

Regarding Masks: The policy of the Archdiocese of Atlanta currently in place regarding masks includes the following:

- For Holy Mass: “Attendance at daily Mass may begin Monday, May 25, on an announced schedule. Churches may also be open for prayer and adoration on an announced schedule...The faithful are required to use face masks.”
- For Confession: “Indoor confessions may take place, with the use of face masks.”
- Children under seven years old and those with medical conditions that make wearing a mask difficult are exempt from this requirement.

Daily Mass Schedule: We will be having only one Mass per day on weekdays until the arrival of our new pastor, Fr. Dow. Please check the schedule accordingly.

Homeschooling Meetup-Sun, Aug 2: Adults are invited to a homeschool meetup on Sunday, August 2 from 1:30 to 2:30 in the parish hall. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss curriculum and to support each other. We will review curriculum for elementary, middle, and high school. Several parishioners will discuss the curriculum that they use. All are encouraged to RSVP, but depending on the number who want to come, we might have to divide into more than one meeting, in different rooms (to respect the limits on numbers of people gathering). Marriage Banns: Let it be known to all here present that Luis Manuel Ortiz, son of Luis and Lisseth of the Ortiz family, and Emily Louise Koschler, daughter of Robert and Louise of the Koschler family, intend to contract marriage between themselves. Therefore, we admonish all that if anyone is aware of any existing impediment that would prohibit marriage between them, that he is obligated to reveal it as soon as possible to the Parish Priest, and this serves as the second publication of these Banns.

Appropriate Dress: In obedience and humility to God and charity to neighbor, *please dress appropriately when attending the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.* Men should be in collared shirts (no T-shirts, graphics, etc.) and long trousers (skin tight pants are never appropriate). Ladies should be in opaque clothing, not tight-fitting, coming up to the neckline front and back, covering the shoulders and upper arms, *skirts coming down below the knee, even when seated.* Wearing a veil is welcome.

Vade Mecum: The priests and seminarians of Our Lady of Guadalupe Seminary realized early on that a book of daily prayers was needed for their use and edification.
