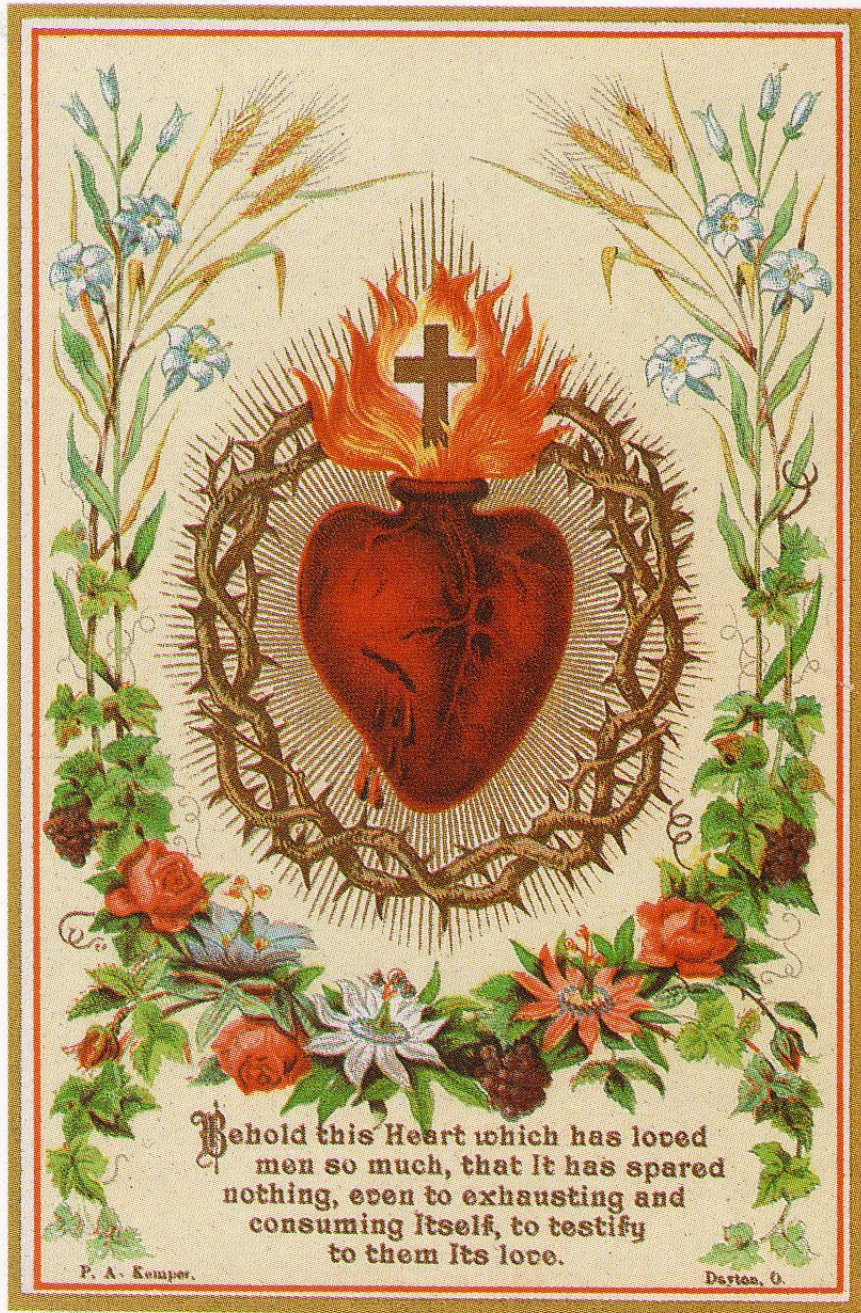

Confessions on Sunday's will be at 7:15am, 9am, and 11am, and will take place in the cry room and in classroom 5 located in the church basement (make a left when you go down the stairs and the room will be directly in front of you).
