Confessions: The revised archdiocesan coronavirus guidelines permit us to return to using the confessionals, the proper and fitting place for the sacrament. Henceforth the cry room and basement will no longer be used for confessions, although the requirement for the penitent to wear a mask remains.

Adjustment to Sunday Mass Times Effective October 18th:

Starting Sunday, October 18th, the schedule will be as follows:

- 8 am Low Mass
- 9:15 to 10:15 am CCD
- 10:30 am High Mass
- 1 pm Low Mass

This slight adjustment to the schedule shifts the high Mass 30 minutes later, which helps the priests to hear more confessions between Masses, and enables the CCD program to have a full hour between the 8 am and 10:30 am Masses.
