Christ the King, October 25, 2020

Today-Christ the King: We will recite the *Act of Consecration of the Human Race to the Sacred Heart of Jesus* after each Mass. This will take the place of the Leonine prayers after the 8am and 1:00pm low Masses. A plenary indulgence may be gained by publicly reciting this *Act of Consecration* today under the usual conditions.

Friday, Oct 30th-Juventutem Event: Young adults 18-35. Dinner at Hook Line & Schooner after the 7:00pm low Mass and Holy Hour of Adoration with Benediction. Please visit juventutematlanta.com for more details.

Reminder-Sunday, Nov 1st Daylight Savings Time ends, "Fall back" 1 Hour: On November 1st at 2am clocks should be turned back one hour.

Sunday, Nov. 1st - All Saints Day Parade: Please join us from 2:30 to 4:30 for an All Saints Day Parade and tailgate in the parking lot! Bring your own picnic. Children are encouraged to dress up as saints and have a sign with the name of their saint. The parade of saints will begin at 3:00. (All participants will be divided into a few big groups in order to maintain the requirements for social distancing, etc.)



Important Note on Indulgences for November: A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Poor Souls, is granted to those who visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. **This indulgence was previously limited to Nov 1-8th. This year, due to the ongoing pandemic, the Apostolic Penitentiary decreed on Oct. 23, 2020, that the faithful can transfer the possibility of achieving indulgences for the faithful departed to any particular day during the whole month of November, for the same total of eight days, but not necessarily contiguous days.** Partial indulgences are granted to those who recite Lauds or Vespers of the Office of the Dead, and to those who recite the prayer "*Requiem aeternam dona eis, Domini, et lux perpetua luceat eis. Requiescant in pace*" ("Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace"). On All Soul's Day (Nov 2) a plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Poor Souls, is granted to those who visit any parish church or public oratory and there recite one Our Father and one Credo. All indulgences whatsoever may be applied to the Poor Souls at any time by way of suffrage (the simple intention to offer them for the Poor Souls is sufficient).

Sunday, Nov. 1st-Homeschool Meetup: Adults are invited to a homeschool meetup on Sunday, November 1st from 10:30 to 11:30 in the social hall.
