Adjustment to Sunday Mass Times Effective October 18th:

Starting Sunday, October 18th, the schedule will be as follows:

- 8 am Low Mass
- 9:15 to 10:15 am CCD
- 10:30 am High Mass
- 1 pm Low Mass

This slight adjustment to the schedule shifts the high Mass 30 minutes later, which helps the priests to hear more confessions between Masses, and enables the CCD program to have a full hour between the 8 am and 10:30 am Masses.

CCD: The CCD program will begin on October 4th with catechist orientation in the classroom area, parent orientation on October 11th, **and the first class on October 18th.** Start time is 9:15am.
