Easter Egg Hunt Today: The Easter Egg hunt today follows the 8:00 am Mass. Children under 6 report to the backyard behind Father Austin's house to the right of the church. Children 6 and over report to the carport of the empty house to the left of the church. If raining the Easter Egg hunt be be reset to Low Sunday, April 11.

April 11, Divine Mercy Sunday: Next Sunday at 3:00 pm, we will have a short talk, sing the Chaplet and have veneration of the Divine Mercy image and relic of St. Faustina led by Deacon Anderson. A plenary indulgence is granted to those who take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or in the tabernacle, recite one *Our Father* and the *Creed*, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus. Those who for a just cause cannot get to church can gain the same indulgence by reciting one *Our Father*, the *Creed*, and a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus before an image of the Divine Mercy.
