**Today, Divine Mercy Sunday:** At 3 pm, there will be a short talk, singing of the Chaplet and veneration of the Divine Mercy image and the relic of St. Faustina led by Deacon Anderson. A plenary indulgence is granted to those who take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or in the tabernacle, recite one *Our Father* and the *Creed*, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus. Those who for a just cause cannot get to church can gain the same indulgence by reciting one *Our Father*, the *Creed*, and a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus before an image of the Divine Mercy.

**Today:** Fr. Smith will be singing a High Mass at Georgia Tech.'s Catholic Center at 1:30 pm.

**Confirmation and CCD classes:** All classes resume today.

**Juventutem Atlanta Outing:** Saturday, Apr. 24, young adults (18-35) attend the 9 am Mass at the parish and carpool to the Braselton, Ga., Artisan Festival to enjoy live music, food trucks, and over 300 vendors.
