On December 10, 1925, Our Lady promised Sister Lucia that she would "assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all those who on the first Saturdays of five consecutive months: confess, receive Holy Communion, pray a Rosary, and keep me company for a quarter of an hour meditating on the fifteen mysteries with the intention of offering me reparation."

Our Lord appeared to Sr. Lucia May 29, 1930 and explained the five kinds of offenses and blasphemies that required reparation: blasphemies against her Immaculate Conception, against her perpetual virginity, against the divine and spiritual maternity, blasphemies involving the rejection and dishonoring of her images, and neglect of implanting in the hearts of children a knowledge and love of their Immaculate Mother.
