This will be every Friday at 7 pm before Mass (except on March 19 when we will have a high Mass in honor of St. Joseph). Please come to participate in this ancient and venerable devotion.

Current Fasting and Abstinence Regulations during Lent:

+ **Fasting** is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are between the ages of 18 and 59.

+ **Abstinence** from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older.

+ Those who are sick, pregnant, nursing or whose health would be adversely affected by fasting or abstinence should not consider themselves bound by these norms.
