Current Fasting and Abstinence Regulations during Lent:

- + **Fasting** is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are between the ages of 18 and 59.
- + **Abstinence** from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older.
- + Those who are sick, pregnant, nursing or whose health would be adversley affected by fasting or abstinence should not consider themselves bound by these norms.
