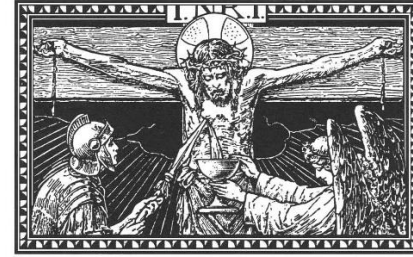
Congratulations to Caleb Aidric Kelly, son of Ryan and Leigh Ann Kelly who was received into the Church through the waters of baptism last week.
