DECEMBER 18 was in former times often celebrated as the Feast of the Expectation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Although it was never in the universal calendar of the Latin Church, it originated in Spain and eventually spread to most Catholic countries. The feast was also commonly called, even in liturgical books, « Santa Maria de la O » because on that day the clerics in the choir after Vespers used to utter a loud and protracted "O", to express the longing of the universe for the coming of the Redeemer. A High Mass used to be sung at a very early hour each morning during its octave, at which all expectant mothers, whether rich or poor, considered it a duty to attend, that they might honor Our Lady's Maternity, and beg her blessing upon themselves.
