

THE TOTAL CONSECRATION TO JESUS THROUGH MARY, according to the method given by St. Louis Marie Grignon de Montfort, is most traditionally done on March 25, the Feast of the Annunciation. It is usually preceded by a 33-day period of preparation. If you would like to participate in this old and wonderful devotion, your preparation would start on February 20. More information on how to participate will be available soon.

THE FEAST OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES, officially the “Feast of the Apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary Immaculate,” commemorates every February 11 the series of eighteen apparitions of the Virgin Mary to Bernadette Soubirous from February 11 to July 16, 1858 in Lourdes, France. She described the lady as wearing a white veil and a blue girdle; she had a golden rose on each foot and held a rosary of pearls. When she asked her name, the lady responded, “I am the Immaculate Conception.” The principle message of Our Lady during the apparitions was to pray and do penance for the conversion of sinners. She also requested a church to be built at the grotto where she appeared, and instructed Bernadette to wash and drink from a spring that mysteriously appeared. After initial skepticism from the Clergy, these claims were eventually declared to be worthy of belief in 1862 after a canonical investigation. Countless miraculous physical and spiritual cures have been attested to with the waters from the spring at Lourdes.

AVE REGINA CÆLORUM is the Marian antiphon that we sing from February 2 until Compline of Wednesday in Holy Week.
