THE SOLEMN BLESSING OF HOLY WATER for the feast of the Epiphany will take place on Thursday, January 5, following the 3 p.m. Eucharistic Benediction. If you would like to have your own water blessed, we politely insist on the following guidelines:


- Only one 1-gallon bottle of water may be blessed per household.
- Please be sure to clearly mark the bottle with your family name.
- Bring the bottle with you to the ceremony ahead of time and place it in the designated area, and take the bottle with you when the blessing has been finished.
- So that we may maintain order and tidiness in the church, please do not drop off bottles early. Any bottles left unclaimed after the blessing will be emptied and discarded.

Lest there arise a spirit of hoarding and superstition, kindly remember that ordinary Holy Water is an equally powerful sacramental. The blessing of Epiphany water only differs in the ceremony, since its provenace is the Eastern Church.

CANDLES FOR CANDLEMAS: This year in preparation for the traditional blessing of candles on February 2, the Feast of the Purification, we are offering for sale a set of candles specifially made for Candlemas. The set consists of two, high-quality church candles, of 51% beeswax, and may be had for \$7 a set. They must be purchased *before* the blessing at Candlemas and may be collected afterwards. Orders may be placed in the bookstore on Sundays, or, with exact change, in the church office during the week.
