THE MARIAN ANTIPHON for the Season after Pentecost is the *Salve Regina*.

THE FEAST OF THE MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD is next Saturday. The Blood of Christ is precious because it is Christ's own great ransom paid for the redemption of mankind. In this belief, as there was to be no remission of sin without the shedding of blood, the *Incarnate Word* not only offered His life for the salvation of the world, but He offered to give up His life by a bloody death, and to hang bloodless, soulless and dead upon the Cross for the salvation of humanity. The feast, celebrated in Spain in the 16th century, was later introduced to Italy by St. Gaspar del Bufalo. On August 10, 1849, Pope Pius IX extended the Feast of the Most Precious Blood to the universal Church to commemorate the anniversary of the liberation of the city of Rome from the revolutionary insurgents in 1849.
